

TOP REASONS TO CONSIDER MICRO-HOSPITALS

1 SMALL FOOTPRINT

The term "micro" is applied because of the noticeably smaller building footprint which typically ranges from 20,000 to 40,000 square feet and consists of 8 ER and 8 inpatient beds. The smaller footprint requires significantly less capital investment and real estate than a traditional hospital, and it allows for more flexibility in site selection.

2 LOW COST

Not only is the cost of construction lower but the overall operational cost to run these facilities is a small percentage of what traditional hospitals require. This is due largely in part to the unique, lean staffing model that is utilized.

For the cost of a single traditional hospital, a health system could build a large network of micro-hospitals across a significant geographic area.

3 STRATEGIC EXPANSION

Micro-hospitals can be deployed as part of an offensive strategy allowing health systems to rapidly expand into new communities at a fraction of the cost and time that would be required for more traditional buildings. Or from a defensive perspective, filling gaps between service areas to defend against competitive growth.

4 ACCESSIBILITY

Micro-hospitals can reduce patient travel time and increase outreach, boosting the ability of health systems to reach new patients. Many organizations have used micro-hospitals to enter growing retail areas to provide convenient healthcare access where patients live, work, and play.
